

## NH Association of Certified Public Managers

The New Hampshire Association of Certified Public Managers (NHACPM) is a professional association of public sector supervisors and managers. To be eligible for active membership, an individual must have earned the designation of Certified Public Supervisor (CPS) or Certified Public Manager (CPM) through a management program accredited by the National Certified Public Manager Consortium, current CPS/CPM students or members of the CPM advisory board.

Managers are certified after satisfactorily completing an extensive program of classroom training, study, research, examinations, and demonstrating their management abilities through completion of individual or team projects.

The NHACPM was chartered by the American Academy of Certified Public Managers in 2000.
